Jurisdiction

"The differences between federal and state courts are defined mainly by *jurisdiction*.

Jurisdiction refers to the kinds of cases a court is authorized to hear."

Federal vs. State Courts - Key Differences via FindLaw


- Federal Courts:
 - Cases in which the United States is a party;
 - Cases involving violations of the U.S. Constitution or federal laws;
 - Cases between citizens of different states over \$75,000; and
 - Bankruptcy, copyright, patent, and maritime law cases.

Federal vs. State Courts - Key Differences via FindLaw

- State Courts:
 - Robberies
 - Traffic violations
 - Broken contracts
 - Family disputes
 - and similar

Note: In some cases, both federal and state courts have jurisdiction.

• Challenged the constitutionality of the Digital Millennium Copyright Act

Watkins v. Alvey, 549 N.E.2d 74 (Ind. Ct. App. 1990)

Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER.gov)



- Federal courts
- Registration required
- 10 cents per page
- Keep a credit card on file, no charge if < \$15 per quarter




Law Books – They're Not Dead Yet!





Public Companies: Cracking the Code of Business Listings

■ D-U-N-S Number

DNB.com

- Unique 9-digit identification number for each physical location of a business.

■ NAICS aka "Nakes"

 North American Industry Classification System

 Used by Federal statistical agencies in Canada, Mexico, and the United States

ACQUISITION

GSA picks Ernst and Young to phase out the DUNS number

Now, instead of the DUNS number, GSA, through Ernst and Young, will use a government-owned unique entity identifier called the SAM Managed Identifier (SAMMI) within SAM and GSA's Integrated Award Environment. This eliminates issues with vendor lock-in associated with the government relying on a private company's proprietary identifier.

Public Companies: Cracking the Code of Business Listings

SIC = Standard Industrial Classification system

- SIC last updated in 1987
- NAICS was established in 1997 to replace SIC
- It is common to still see both used today!

The Significance of the Form 8-K

Form 8-K is the form on which public companies report, on a current basis, the occurrence of significant corporate events.

• A reportable event is a transaction or occurrence of major significance.


